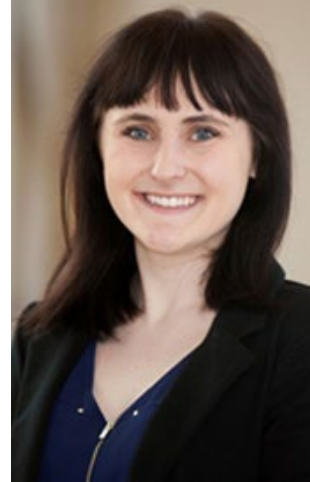

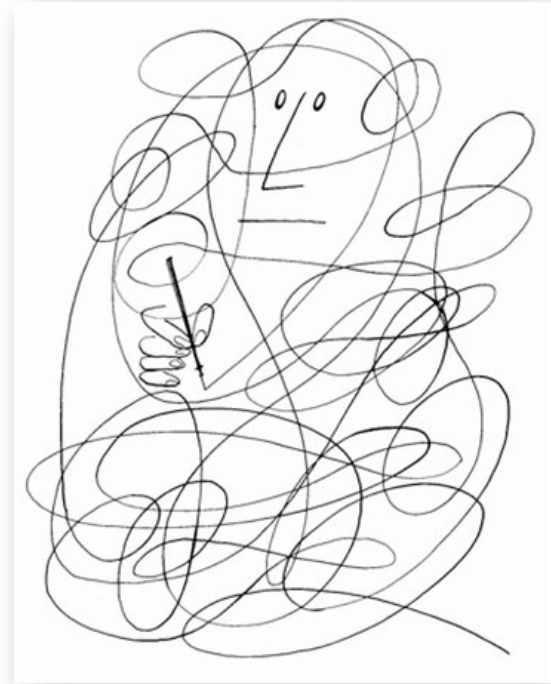

EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION

- You are free to communicate as an individual, but not with your ACRL title

“Individual members are welcome (and encouraged) to sign statements about which they feel strongly. But as soon as individuals also list a section or division, along with their name, they have moved from being an individual to becoming a representative of a group and that brings separate responsibilities.”

- Staff and Board liaisons are here to help you.



- ALA is one legal entity of which ACRL is a part
- ALA is a 501(c)3; limits political activity but needs your advocacy
- ACRL is self-sustaining: no direct financial support from ALA
- Divisions pay ALA an indirect cost on non-dues revenues generated

Unused Funds

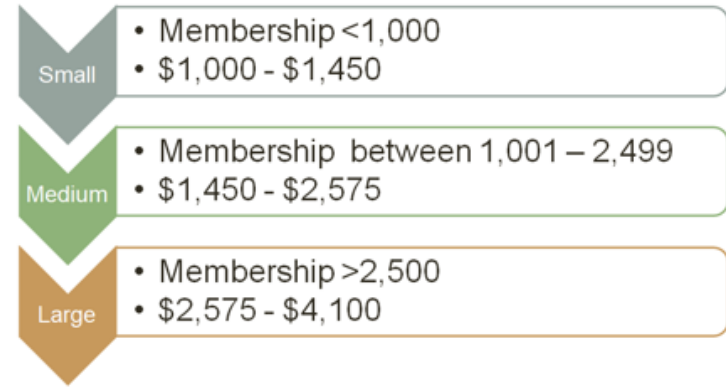
- No funds carried over to next fiscal year

Reimbursement Requests

- FY24 deadline: August 15
- Allow 4-6 weeks for processing
- Form available on ACRL website

- Section chairs approve requests for funding that are submitted by committee members before sending them along to ACRL.

Section Basic Services Budgets



Basic Services Budget ranges based on the section membership as of August 31. Each section receives \$1,000 as a base and an additional .75 for each member over 400.

Sections have used basic services funds to sponsor Emerging Leaders, to support liaison activities, to support member engagement initiatives, to provide speaker honoraria, and to carry out the work of section committees. More details will be provided when the budget memos are distributed late fall.

Discussion and Interest Group Information

- ✓ **Discussion Group** appointments are for 1-year terms.
- ✓ DGs require least one convener each year to maintain active status.
- ✓ DG leaders can serve up to 5 consecutive terms.
- **Interest Group** leader appointments are for 3-year terms.
- IGs require three leaders:
- Incoming-Convener, Convener, and Past Convener.
- Must ask the ACRL Board to renew (or sunset) every 3 years.

Each IG receives a budget of \$150 per year.

- Unused funds are not carried over to the next fiscal year.
- All reimbursement requests due by August 15 (before end of ALA fiscal year).
- IG leaders approve requests for funding that are submitted by interest group members before sending them along to ACRL.
